TOWYN CUPS (18 Holes Four Ball Better Ball Medal - Stroke Allowance = 3/4 of handicap)

JOYCE MEMORIAL CUP - Awarded for best nett score in August Medal competitions (Cave Silver Medal, Tomlins Cup, & Jubilee Cup) by a Club Member aged 55 years and over.

SADLER CUP - Awarded for best nett score in August Medal competitions (Cave Silver Medal, Tomlins Cup & Jubilee Cup) by a Club Member aged 19 years and under.

MILLENNIUM TROPHY - Awarded for best total of points over 70 in the two August Stableford competitions (Ward Cup & Aberdovey Town Vase) by a Club Member aged 70 years and over.

Medals and Stableford events will be handicap qualifying competitions unless deemed otherwise under the conditions of CONGU.

CONDITIONS (Men's Section)

TEES: White tees (Shadow Competition behind Ward Cup – yellows tees)

KNOCK-OUT COMPETITIONS: Please do **NOT** enter these competitions unless you are available to compete in **ALL** rounds.

HANDICAP REQUIREMENTS: ADULTS/GENERAL – Full handicap except for the Allcock Bowl & Dyfi Cups Knock Outs (limit 24) and the Hogg Trophies (limit 24). In the case of the Knock-out competitions, **current** handicaps will apply in each round and not the handicaps applicable at the start of the week, if these have altered.

Eligibility: Members **MUST HAVE** a valid CONGU handicap before the Entry Closing date.

Any members not handicapped at Aberdovey must produce a current handicap certificate from their Home Club as prior to playing in their first competition. PLAYERS HOLDING ACTIVE AND INACTIVE HANDICAPS MAY ENTER BUT ONLY THOSE WITH AN ACTIVE HANDICAP AT THE TIME OF THE COMPETITION MAY TAKE A PRIZE. No one may take two prizes. JUNIORS (i.e. under 18 years of age) IN ADULT COMPETITIONS: Juniors require handicaps of **9** and below to enter. It is the player's responsibility to ensure they play off the correct handicap and report their scores to their Home Club for handicapping purposes.

CLOSING DATES for Entries: all entries must be completed on the relevant entry forms. For the Cave Silver Medal, Allcock Bowl and Dyfi Cups, the latest time will be **9 a.m. on Monday 9th August 2010** and the draw for these events will be posted on Thursday 12th August 2010. Towyn Cups (Saturday 21st August) can be booked via BRS or in the Pro's Shop. For all other events, entries will close at 4.00 p.m. on the previous day. Starting times will be posted on BRS.

ENTRANCE FEES: Cave Silver Medal - **£5.00 per player** (covers both days and separate prizes for each round). All other events **£5.00 per player**. Entries should be made on the forms provided and submitted, with fees, to the Office. For the Towyn Cups, please ensure that the entrance fee is paid to the Pro's Shop before play. **Without the fee, no entry will be valid.**

STARTING TIMES & PARTNERS: In all events except the Towyn Cups, the Office will allocate starting times and players must be prepared to accept these.

Towyn Cups - An entry sheet will be posted on BRS and competitors should make up their own fours and enter against the preferred time.

The Committee reserves the right to disqualify players who do not report to the Starter, ready to proceed to 1st tee, 5 minutes before their starting time. Competitors reporting late for Match Play events will be penalised by the loss of the 1st hole and, if more than 5 minutes late, by loss of the match. The clock on the Professional's Shop will be used for all timings.

BUGGIES: Only those members who normally use buggies and those, whose medical condition requires them, will be allowed to use these vehicles in competitions. (Medical certificates must be produced).

GPS Use: In accordance with R&A Rule 14-3, the use of distance measuring devices is not permitted: there is no local rule in place to permit the use of such equipment. Penalty for breach of rule: disqualification.

PRACTICE: In accordance with rule 7-1[b] competitors may not practice on the course before a stroke play event, whether playing morning or afternoon, EXCEPT that a competitor shall be allowed to play in the Allcock Bowl and a stroke play event, OR the Allcock Bowl and the Dyfi Cups, OR the Dyfi Cups and a stroke play event on the same day.(i.e. any two out of three competitions) Otherwise practice must be confined to the designated practice areas and the practice putting green.
Competitors have priority on the practice areas at all times.

SLOW PLAY: The Green Committee shall have the right to disqualify any competitor or competitors who, in its opinion, have been guilty of slow play.

TIES: Where ties occur, the best score for the last 9 holes will decide; then the last 6; the last 3 or the last hole, except in the Cave Silver Medal where the last 18 holes will decide; then the last 9 etc.

STANDARDS of DRESS: Jacket and tie (preferably Club tie) must be worn for presentation of prizes.

PRIZE-GIVING: The Committee expects all prize winners to attend the Presentation on **Saturday 21st August 2010 at 8.00 p.m.** In the event of non-attendance without a prior apology, vouchers will be withheld.

Soft Spikes are mandatory.
